Winter in South Carolina

While summer temperatures are usually steady in South Carolina—averaging a humid 90 F—winter temperatures are variable. Coastal areas experience mild daytime temperatures—perfect for a walk on the beach—while overnight lows near 38 F warrant an insulated jacket. The further inland you go, the cooler it

gets. Expect temperatures to be brisk during the day and close to freezing at night.

What to pack: While you won't need a heavy coat in South Carolina, you will want to pack sweaters and a mid-weight jacket for layering. Choose pants or jeans and a long-sleeve shirt to keep you comfortable. And throw in one short sleeved-shirt for good measure, as you may get a day in the 60s. A hat, gloves, and a scarf are rarely necessary unless for fashion purposes only. From tripsavy.com

GETTING AROUND THE CHARLESTON AREA


