



## **David W. Bartee**

David Bartee serves as the Courts IT Director for the Fairfax County Court Technology Office (CrTO), a centralized office supporting three Fairfax Courts; Circuit Court & Records, General District Court and Juvenile & Domestic Relations District Court and ad hoc support to the Office of the Commonwealth's Attorney, Office of the Sheriff, Fairfax Bar Association and Fairfax Law Library. This Office was created in 2007 to lead several court technology expansion projects, and further develop programs to integrate modern technology with new and existing court processes and proceedings. During this time, the CrTO developed and implemented a state-of-the-art Courtroom Technology Management System, integrating evidence presentation, video teleconference, and user interface capabilities for courtroom trials, hearings, and arraignments.

From 2001 to 2007, Mr. Bartee served as the IT Project Portfolio Manager for the Fairfax County Department of Information Technology, providing management and budget oversight for nearly 100 IT projects and a \$40 million investment portfolio. Prior to 2001, Mr. Bartee spent 12 years with the Juvenile & Domestic Relations District Court where he served in multiple administrative and management capacities, and oversaw several successful technology related projects. Prior to Fairfax County, Mr. Bartee was employed in the private sector in various management, contracting and financial capacities.

Mr. Bartee holds a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from James Madison University, and a Master's degree in Public Administration from George Mason University. He resides in Fairfax County, volunteers in the community and is involved with several local charitable organizations and events.
